Motion by Wakefield to accept the Amendment to Engineer-Owner Agreement but in the future to bid it out, second by Steffen and called three times for discussion with roll call vote: Wakefield-aye, Pedersen-aye, Dahl-aye, Steffen-aye, Olson-aye, and carried. Motion by Pedersen to sign the Maintenance Certification for County Federal Aid Project, second by

Dahl and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried. There was also discussion on the NDDOT Rail letter that was presented. The Commission would like to discuss this at the next meeting that RS/911C Oien can attend.

Motion by Wakefield to accept the highest bid on the Ford tractor and reject the remainder of the bids.

Chairman Olson opened the floor to the Beer and Liquor license for the Sutton Pub. Motion by Pedersen to accept the Beer and Liquor license for the Sutton Pub, second by Steffen and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Olson opened the floor to the November 6th Meeting Minutes mistake. There was discussion on the error that was discovered after the minutes had already been approved. Motion by Wakefield to reapprove the November 6th meeting minutes as amended, second by Pedersen and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Olson opened the floor to the Weed Officer. The County received one application for the position. There was discussion on the budget the County has for the Weed department. Motion by Wakefield to have Auditor Quast contact Wallery to attend the next regular meeting, second by Pedersen and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Olson opened the floor to the Old Courthouse/New Courthouse. There was discussion on the status of the law suit and the new courthouse building.

Motion by Steffen to adjourn meeting at 2:38 pm and meet again in regular session on December 18th at 1 pm, second by Pedersen and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays and carried.
