COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, May 22, 2024 at 10:00 am.

Chairman Wakefield opened the meeting and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Wakefield took roll call and present were Commissioners Averill-Present by zoom, Tranby, Zorn-absent, Edland, and Wakefield. Also present was State's Attorney Tenneson, and Sheriff Candidates Michaelis and Haaland.

Chairman Wakefield opened the floor for any changes to the agenda. Motion by Edland to approve the agenda as presented, second by Tranby and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Wakefield opened the floor to conduct interviews for the interim Sheriff's position. Amberly Michaelis was interviewed.

Motion by Tranby to take a recess until the next applicant has joined, second by Edland and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Chairman Wakefield reconvened the meeting and reopened the floor to continue conducting interviews for the interim Sheriff's position. Marcus Haaland was interviewed.

A vote was taken from each of the Commission for their 1st and 2nd choices for the position. 3 votes for Amberly and 1 vote Marcus. Motion by Tranby to offer the Sheriff position to Amberly, second by Edland and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried. Amberly rejoined the meeting and accepted the position. Motion by Tranby to hire Amber as interim Sheriff, second by Edland and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays, and carried.

Motion by Tranby to adjourn meeting at 10:44 am and meet again in regular meeting on May 20th at 9:30 am, second by Edland and called three times for discussion with all ayes, no nays and carried.
